Is the E46 rare? The BMW Registry tells us that 26,202 E46 coupes were sold in North America. Just 1128 came in LSB, the bulk of them from 2001–03. After the M3's mid-2003 “lifecycle impulse” (which, for some reason, is BMW-speak for “facelift”) just 154 LSB coupes appeared, and there were none in 2005–06.

Is the E46 rare? The BMW Registry tells us that 26,202 E46 coupes were sold in North America. Just 1128 came in LSB, the bulk of them from 2001–03. After the M3's mid-2003 "lifecycle impulse" (which, for some reason, is BMW-speak for "facelift") just 154 LSB coupes appeared, and there were none in 2005–06.

Does E46 need premium? The fabled e39 and e46 cars from the early 2000s each featured 11.5 to 1 compression, which is some of the highest found in a street car. BMW recommends only using premium in these cars, as with all their cars, but it's models like these where you'll feel the effects most.
